

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant in the amount of \$150,057 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, to fund the FSM Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Disease Capacity Building Program from August 01, 2016, to July 31, 2017, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, the United States through the Department of Health
2 and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
3 issued a Notice of Award with grant number: NU5OCK00381-03-01 on
4 August 04, 2016, in the amount of \$150,057; and

5 WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to fund the FSM Project
6 entitled: "Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious
7 Disease Capacity Building" specifically for the enhancement of
8 infection disease investigation, outbreak control, testing,
9 surveillance, and information systems in the FSM; and

10 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia provides that for an agreement on
12 federal financial assistance to be valid it must be approved by
13 Congress by resolution; and

14 WHEREAS, the FSM Government expresses appreciation to the
15 United States Government for the federal grant programs made
16 available to the Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Nineteenth Congress of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia, Seventh Special Session, 2016, that Congress

1 hereby approves and accepts the \$150,057 grant from the U.S.
2 Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease
3 Control and Prevention, to fund the FSM Epidemiology and
4 Laboratory Capacity for Infections Disease Capacity Building
5 Program, including all the terms and conditions thereof; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
7 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
8 of Micronesia, the Secretary of Health and Social Affairs and the
9 United States Embassy in Kolonia.
