- 17 understanding, not to mention some personal inconvenience; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the Congress will have difficulty recruiting a person who is
- 19 equally stalwart, personable, and professional; and
- 20 WHEREAS, it is not deemed inappropriate to commend a person not only for
- 21 a job well done, but also for one done above and beyond the call of duty,
