A RESOLUTION

Commending Mr. Wendoline Gomez for his long and distinguished career as a public servant in the field of health services.

- 1 WHEREAS, Mr. Wendolin Gomez was born on December 8, 1912 in Uh Municipality,
- 2 State of Ponape; and
- 3 WHEREAS, at the age of 15, he began working as an interpreter and driver
- 4 with an agency of health services administered by the Japanese Government; and
- 5 WHEREAS, showing promise, Mr. Gomez, after some training, became a health
- 6 assistant at the Hospital in Ponape; and
- 7 WHEREAS, during WWII, Mr. Gomez remained with the Japanese medical staff
- 8 in Kahmar, Nett, providing medical care for both the Japanese and Ponapeans;

- 10 WHEREAS, after the War, Mr. Gomez was one of the first Ponapeans recruited
- 11 by the U.S. Navy to work at the Hospital; and
- WHEREAS, in 1951, as the only laboratory technician at the Hospital,
- 13 Mr. Gomez performed his duties diligently and without complaint; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Gomez has received commendations and recognitions throughout
- 15 his career; and
- 16 WHEREAS, in 1957, Mr. Gomez received a certificate and a letter of
- 17 commendation for outstanding and dedicated service to the Trust Territory
- 18 Government; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in 1967, Mr. Gomez was appointed by High Commissioner Goding as
- 20 the representative of the Trust Territory Government to an Atomic Energy
- 21 Commission survey team; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Gomez was promoted in 1960 to the position of laboratory
