CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION NO. 1-65, C.D.1

A RESOLUTION

Urging the Secretary of the U.S. Department of the Interior to approve EDLF operating regulations.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Economic Development Loan Fund is the only source of economic
- 2 development loan capital now available for use by the Trust Territory of the
- 3 Pacific Islands to promote private sector investment in economic development
- 4 projects; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the 1975 moratorium on EDLF loans has greatly hampered economic
- 6 development in the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, identified potential economic development projects are in limbo
- 8 and cannot be started due to lack of loan funds; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a new EDLF director was hired five months ago but still has no
- 10 loan funds to distribute; and
- WHEREAS, the end of the EDLF moratorium on loans is being delayed by lack
- 12 of approval by the U.S. Secretary of the Interior of new EDLF regulations,
- 13 which have been submitted to him; and
- WHEREAS, early commencement of EDLF loan operations is extremely important
- 15 to economic development prospects in the Federated States of Micronesia; now,
- 16 therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the First Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia,
- 18 Second Regular Session, 1979, that the Secretary of the United States Department
- 19 of the Interior is urged to approve pending EDLF operating regulations as soon
- 20 as possible; and
- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
- 22 transmitted to Cecil D. Andrus, Secretary of the U.S. Department of the
