A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by Public Law No. 20-57, by amending sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the states of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

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date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 2(a) to 2(af) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 2(ag) shall be the Secretary of Education or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 2(ah) to $[\frac{2(am)}{2}]$ 2(a3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b), 3(1)(c), 3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j), 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r), 3(2)(b), 3(2)(c), 3(2)(d), 3(2)(e) [and], 3(2)(o), 3(3)(d), 3(3)(n), 3(3)(t) and 3(3)(x) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(3)(f), 3(3)(1) and

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1	3(3)(m) of this act shall be the Lukenmenlap of Kitti; the
2	allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(3)(q)
3	and 3(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility
4	Corporation; the allottee of fund appropriated under
5	subsections 4(7)(a), 4(7)(b), 4(7)(c), 4(7)(d) and 4(7)(e)
6	shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The
7	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 4(1),

14	Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
15	subsection 4(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
16	Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
17	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
18	September 30, 2020."
19	Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
20	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
21	becoming law without such approval.
