## TWENTIETH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83 and 20-94, in order to appropriate \$330,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-67 and 20-83, is hereby further amended
to read as follows:

"Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to 4 5 appropriate the sum of [<del>\$93,404,022</del>] \$93,734,022 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 6 7 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the 8 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the 9 National Government of the Federated States of 10 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, 11 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human 12 Resources Development. The National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; 13 14 EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain 10 15 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is 16 reflected in the budget for the Department of Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as 17 18 follows:"
