A BILL FOR AN ACT

L5	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
L6	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
L 7	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

L9	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
20	designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
21	appropriated under subsections 2(a) to 2(af) and 2(ay)
22	of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government
23	or his designee; [the allottee of funds appropriated
24	under subsection 2(ag) shall be the Secretary of
25	Education or his designee; the allottee of funds

appropriated under subsections [2(ah)] 2(ag) to 2(a2) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b), 3(1)(c), 3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j), 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r), 3(2)(b), 3(2)(c), 3(2)(d), 3(2)(e), 3(2)(o), 3(3)(d), 3(3)(n), 3(3)(t) and 3(3)(x) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(3)(f), 3(3)(1) and 3(3)(m) of this act shall be the Lukenmenlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(3)(q) and 3(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation; the allottee of fund appropriated under subsections 4(7)(a), 4(7)(b), 4(7)(c), 4(7)(d) and 4(7)(e) shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his The allottee of the funds appropriated under designee. subsections 4(1), 4(3), 4(6) and 4(7) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
