A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$222,223 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, in order to provide for the matching fund for the Airport Improvement Projects (AIP), and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Appropriation. The sum of \$222,223 is hereby
- 2 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 3 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.
- 4 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in
- 5 section 1 is to provide for the matching funds of the AIP Grant
- 6 Awards made by the U.S. Federal Aviation Authority in September
- 7 2017 for the Design of Yap Airfield Rehabilitation, Yap E-Vault
- 8 Design/Upgrade and Kosrae E-Vault Design/Upgrade.
- 9 Section 3. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
- 10 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
- 11 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
- 12 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
- 13 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
- 14 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
- 15 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
- 16 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
- 17 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
- 18 section 1 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
