A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$88,874,877 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions, and Capital and Human Resources Development, and other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; 2 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be 3 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of 4 Micronesia; (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be 5 6 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated 7 States of Micronesia; 8 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia; 9 10 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these 11 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following 12 13 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act: (i) Section 8, subsection (11)(a) through (d) -14 15 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective State Supreme Court; and 16 17 (ii) Section 9, subsection (i)(a) and (b) - the 18 allottee of these funds shall be the President of 19 the COM-FSM. 20 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to 21 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of 22 September 30, 2019; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds 23 appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse. 24
