PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-31

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$4,200,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICROSPETA

1	Section 1. The sum of \$4,200,000, or so much thereof as
2	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
3	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
4	ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding public
5	projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae,
6	Pohnpei and Chuuk States. The fund shall be apportioned as

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- 1 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
- 2 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
- 3 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
- 4 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
- 5 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
- 6 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
- 7 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
- 8 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his
- 9 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3
- 10 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
- 11 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the
- 12 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) to 3(n)
- 13 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
- 14 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
- 15 3(o) to 3(v) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak
- 16 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
- 17 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(f), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(1),
- 18 4(1)(m), 4(2)(b) and 4(2)(c) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
- 19 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
- 20 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),
- 21 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i) and 4(2)(j) shall be the
- 22 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications
- 23 and Infrastructure or his designee. The allottee of funds
- 24 appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act
- 25 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The

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1	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this
2	act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
3	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this
4	act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
5	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this
6	act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority
7	of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
8	shall lapse on September 30, 2019.
9	Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11	becoming law without such approval.
