AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-60, by amending sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the states of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes. 7	Section 5. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-60 is hereby
8	amended to read as follows:
9	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
10	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
11	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
12	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
13	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
14	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
15	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
16	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
17	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18	appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
19	section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State
20	or his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated
21	under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the
22	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
23	designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
24	appropriated under subsections 3(a) to 3(o) of this act
25	shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his

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1	designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2	subsections 3(p) to 3(ad) of this act shall be the Mayor
3	of Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the
4	allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
5	4(2)(e), $4(2)(g)$ and $4(2)(m)$ of this act shall be the
6	Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of
7	funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(0) of this act
8	shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). The
9	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
10	5(1), $5(3)$ and $6(6)$ of this act shall be the Governor of
11	Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
12	appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be
13	the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the
14	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4)
15	of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
16	Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
17	subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
18	Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
19	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
20	September 30, 2020."
