AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61 and 20-69, by amending sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the states of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
