PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-94

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67 and 20-83, in order to appropriate \$9,869,296 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, and to change the intended use of certain line items, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-67 and 20-83, is hereby further amended

- 14 retain 10 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant
- funds as is reflected in the budget for the Department of
- 16 Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be
- 17 apportioned as follows:"
