
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, by adding a new section 211, to amend title 3 F.S.M.C. section 305, as enacted by Public Law No. 20-19, and to amend title 4 F.S.M.C., as amended, by adding a new section 126, to establish limits on the representation funds of certain officials of the National Government, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of
2 Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, is hereby further amended
3 by adding a new section 211 to read as follows:

4 "Section 211. President's Representation Funds
5 Appropriation Limits.
6 Congress may appropriate certain funds for
7 discretionary use by the President and Vice-President
8 (Representation Funds) by appropriating funds into the
9 "Office of the President: Contractual Services" line
10 item of the budget, or any other similar line item
11 within an appropriations bill. The Representation
12 Fund appropriation of the President and Vice-President
13 shall not exceed \$100,000 per fiscal year."

14 Section 2. Section 305 of title 3 of the Code of the
15 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as enacted by Public
16 Law No. 2-19, is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 305. Members' Representation Funds
18 Appropriation Limits.

1 (1) Congress may appropriate certain funds for
2 discretionary use by individual members
3 (Representation Funds) by appropriating funds into the
4 "Speaker and Members: Contractual Services" line item
5 of the budget, or any other similar line item within
6 an appropriations bill. The share of Representation
7 Fund appropriations dedicated to any particular member
8 of Congress shall not exceed \$100,000 per fiscal year.
9 An increase in the above cap of representation funds
10 shall not apply to the Congress enacting said
11 increase.

12 (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) of this section,
13 Congress may appropriate certain funds for
14 discretionary use by individual members
15 (Representation Funds) by appropriating funds into
16 each State Delegation Office "Contractual Services"
17 line item of the budget, or any other similar line
18 item within an appropriations bill. The share of
19 Representation Fund appropriations dedicated to each
20 delegation shall not exceed \$50,000 per member per
21 fiscal year."

22 Section 3. Title 4 of the Code of the Federated States of
23 Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, is hereby further amended
24 by adding a new section 126 to read as follows:

25 "Section 126. Chief Justice's Representation Funds
