

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-157 and 20-179, by amending section 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146 and 20-179, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$7,000,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$3,000,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs for the people of Chuuk State.
