A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 2 of Public Law No. 17-59, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-66 and 17-70, 17-77, 17-86, 18-21, 18-29, 18-64, 18-83, 19-18, 19-113, 20-126 and 21-25, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the state of Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
