A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$64,677,508 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions, capital improvement projects, and other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

The President shall report to 12 Congress within one month of the last day of each financial 13 quarter all amounts reprogrammed inter or intra a department, 14 office or agency. 15 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 16 dates. 17 (1) General provisions. 18 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 19 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited 20 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 21 22 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for 23 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be

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necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in

this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess

1	of the sums appropriated.
2	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
3	appropriated by this act are as follows:
4	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
5	be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;
6	(b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall
7	be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
8	Micronesia;
9	(c) Section 4 — the allottee of these funds shall
10	be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated
11	States of Micronesia;
12	(d) Section 5 — the allottee of these funds shall
13	be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
14	Micronesia;
15	(e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
16	funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
17	Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
18	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
19	(i) Section 8, subsection (11)(a) through (m)
20	- the allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the
21	FSM Congress;
22	(ii) Section 8, subsection (12)(c) through (f)
23	- the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice
24	of the respective State Supreme Court; and
25	(ii) Section 9 (1)(a) through (d) $-$ the

1	allottee of these funds shall be the President of the COM
2	FSM.
3	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
4	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
5	September 30, 2020; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
6	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.
7	Section 13. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9	becoming law without such approval.
