A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-78, 19-96, 19-132, 19-163, 20-03, 20-25, 20-58, 20-76, 20-116, 21-29 and 21-64, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social program in the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

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Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended 1 by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-72, 19-96, 20-25, 20-116, 2 21-29 and 21-64, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and 4 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall 5 6 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for 7 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 8 9 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 10 are used solely for the purpose specified in this 11 12 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess 13 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds 14 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of 15 funds appropriated under subsection 2(h) of this act 16 17 shall be the President of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act 18 shall be the President of the Federated States of 19 20 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 21 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j) and 22 (k) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town 23 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under 24 subsection 3(y) of this act shall be the Mayor of 25

Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the 1 2 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(g) and 4(2)(h) shall be the Secretary of the 3 Department of Transportation, Communications and 4 5 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated 6 under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(d) of 7 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; and the allottee of funds appropriated 8 under subsections 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(h) of this act 9 10 shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 11 12  $5(1)\left[\frac{5(3)}{7}\right]$  and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. 13 The 14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development 15 16 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under 17 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee. The 18 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) 19 20 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas 21 Development Authority. The allottee of funds 22 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority 23 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by 24 this act shall lapse on September 30, [2020] 2022." 25
