A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121, 19-05, 19-34, 19-57, 19-74, 19-107, 20-18, 20-24, 20-80, 20-112, 21-28, 21-106, 21-131 and 21-177, by amending sections 3 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-113, 18-121, 19-05, 19-34, 19-107, 20-18, 20-24, 20-112, 21-28 and 21-131, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 10 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 11 12 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 13 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not 14 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The 15 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 16 17 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that 18 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 19 20 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated 21 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap 22 State or his designee. The allottee of funds 23 appropriated under section 3 shall be the President or 24 his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds 25 appropriated under section 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e),

1 (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (u)2 and (y) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the 3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(v) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his 4 5 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under 6 section 4 of this act shall be the President or his 7 designee, EXCEPT that the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(a) shall be the Secretary of the 8 Department of Education; the allottee of funds 9 10 appropriated under sections 4(1)(c), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(h), 4(2) and 4(3)(a) to 4(3)(j) shall be Secretary of the 11 12 Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds 13 14 appropriated under section 4(1)(d) shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under 15 section 4(1)(f) shall be the Nett District Government; 16 17 the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(g) 18 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and Development. The allottee of funds appropriated 19 20 under sections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the 21 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee 22 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act 23 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The 24 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of 25 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government

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or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2022." Section 3.
