A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 21-185, to appropriate \$665,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, to provide funding for the Federated States of Micronesia's membership fees and activities in INTERPOL and to fund the COM-FSM Endowment Fund, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
