PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-01

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-178, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 therein, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated thereof, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-178 is hereby 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 3. 17	amended to read as follows:
18	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
19	lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
20	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
21	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
22	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
23	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
24	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
25	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that

no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 1 2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated 3 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap 4 State or his designee. The allottee of funds 5 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT 6 7 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(ad) of this act shall be the President of COM-FSM or 8 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under 9 10 subsections 3(ae) to 3(ak) of this act shall be the 11 Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this 12 13 act shall be the President of the Federated States of 14 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee 15 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(q) of this 16 act shall be the President of COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 17 18 4(1)(s) of this act shall be the Mayor of Madolenhimw Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of 19 20 funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(t) of this act 21 shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State or his designee; 22 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the 23 24 Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs 25 or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated

2	be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his
3	designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under

6	Department of Transportation, Communications and
7	Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
8	appropriated under subsections 4(3)(k) of this act shall
9	be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and
10	Development or his designee; The allottee of the funds
11	appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of
12	this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
13	designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
14	subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
15	Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the
16	funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
17	shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
18	the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
19	5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
20	Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
21	funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
22	30, 2020."

23 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the 24 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its 25 becoming law without such approval.
