PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-146

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48, 20-63, 20-71, 20-156, 20-175, 21-22 and 21-52, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs in the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by 2 Public Laws Nos. 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-48, 20-175 and 3 21-52, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 4 "Section 5. 3	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended
4	by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48,
5	20-63, 20-156 and 21-22, is hereby further amended to read as
6	follows:
7	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
8	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
9	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
10	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
11	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
12	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
13	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
14	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
15	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
16	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
17	under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the
18	State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds
19	appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
20	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
21	designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
22	appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and 3(1(b) of this
23	act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee,
24	the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
25	4(1)(c) through 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(3)(k), 4(3)(q),

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1	4(3)(s), 4(3)(af), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d) and 4(4)(f), shall be
2	the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee
3	of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b),
4	4(1)(f), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h),
5	4(2)(i), $4(2)(j)$ and $4(3)(x)$ shall be the Secretary of the
6	Department of Transportation, Communications and
7	Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
8	appropriated under subsections 4(3)(f), 4(3)(i), 4(3)(q)
9	4(3)(w) and 4(3)(aa) of this act shall be the Luhk en
10	Moanlap of Kitti, the allottee of funds appropriated under
11	subsection 4(3)(ad) of this act shall be the Chief Justice
12	of Madolenihmw or his designee, the allottee of funds
13	appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall
14	be the Chief Justice of Kitti or his designee. The
15	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
16	5(1)(2) and 5(1)(7) of this act shall be the Governor of
17	Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of
18	funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(3) of this act
19	shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority
20	(MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
21	subsections 5(1)(n) and 5(1)(4) of this act shall be the
22	Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the
23	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(m)
24	of this act shall be the FSM Telecommunication
25	Corporation; the allottee of funds appropriated under

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1	subsection 5(1)(5) of this act shall be the Southern
2	Namoneas Development Authority (SNDA); the allottee of
3	funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(6) of this act
4	shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
5	authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
6	by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2022."
7	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9	becoming law without such approval.
