PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-186

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-54, 21-71, 21-82, 21-103, 21-107 and 21-158, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by

17	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by
18	Public Laws Nos. 21-54, 21-71, 21-107 and 21-158, is hereby
19	further amended to read as follows:
20	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
21	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
22	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
23	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
24	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
25	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these

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1	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
2	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
3	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
4	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
5	under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
6	State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
7	funds appropriated under subsection 2(f) of this act shall
8	be the President of the COM-FSM Institute. The allottee
9	of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
10	shall be the President of the Federated States of
11	Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
12	funds appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall
13	be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
14	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of
15	this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
16	designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
17	section 4(1) and 4(3)(1) of this act shall be the Vice
18	President; The allottee of funds appropriated under
19	subsections 4(1)(a) and 4(2)(j) of this act shall be the
20	Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
21	Communications and Infrastructure or his designee, except
22	that the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
23	4(2)(e), 4(4)(j), 4(4)(k), 4(4)(l) and 4(4)(m) of this act
24	shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the
25	allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(1),

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1	4(3)(d) and 4(3)(f) of this act shall be the Secretary of
2	the Department of Education or his designee; the allottee
3	of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(h) of this act
4	shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds
5	appropriated under subsection 4(2)(m) of this act shall be
6	the Mayor of Nukuoro Municipal Government or his designee;
7	the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
8	4(3)(a), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(i) and 4(3)(k) of
9	this act shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; the
10	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(c) of
11	this act shall be the Chief Justice of Madolenihmw
12	Municipal Government; the allottee of funds appropriated
13	under subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the
14	Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds appropriated
15	under subsection 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the Speaker
16	of Isokonedi of Kitti; the allottee of funds appropriated
17	under subsection 4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Director
18	of Pohnpei Public Safety. The allottee of the funds
19	appropriated under sections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
20	shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the
21	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)
22	of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development
23	Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated
24	under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
25	Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the funds

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1	appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
2	the Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds
3	appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be
4	the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee.
5	The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
6	appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
7	2022."
8	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
10	becoming law without such approval.
