PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-221

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by Public Law No. 21-210 to appropriate \$7,728,555 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, to provide supplemental funding for the operations of the National Government; Agencies, Boards, Authorities, and Commissions; National Election Commission; Grants, Subsidies and Contributions; Capital and Human Resources Development; to raise the employment ceiling; to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
