BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

"Section 3. Elections.
(1) Except as otherwise provided in this act, election of delegates shall be held in accordance with title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated).
(2) The election of delegates shall be held during a special election on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 2019.
(3) Each person voting for delegates shall be permitted to vote for one at-large seat and two district delegate seats in their election district. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for a district seat shall be the delegates to the Convention from the representative district.
(4) The Convention shall be the sole judge of the elections, returns, and qualifications of its members; 9 becoming law without such approval.
