I am pleased to transmit the following Congressional Act, which I have signed to become Public Law No. 21-106:

Congressional Act No. 21-113, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-99, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NOS. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121, 19-05, 19-34, 19-57, 19-74, 19-107, 20-18, 20-24, 20-80, 20-112, AND 21-28, BY AMENDING SECTION 5 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

This Act is changing the use of funds previously appropriated under Section 5(4)(g) of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended, from "Solar lighting system and power generators for housing affected by Typhoon Maysak" to "Humanitarian assistance".

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 21-188

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121, 19-05, 19-34, 19-57, 19-74, 19-107, 20-18, 20-24, 20-80, 20-112 and 21-28, by amending section 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121, 19-05, 19-34, 19-57,  
3 19-74, 20-18 and 20-80, is hereby further amended to read as  
4 follows:

5           "Section 5. Of the \$2,800,000 appropriated in this act,  
6 \$1,200,000 is appropriated for public projects and social  
7 programs for the people of the state of Chuuk.


