- 10 America has notified the United Nations that he will begin the
- 11 process of formally withdrawing from the World Health
- 12 Organization; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the United States of America has provided significant
- 14 funding, expertise and political authority to the World Health
- 15 Organization throughout its membership, and withdraw from the
- 16 organization will hinder the important work done by the World
- 17 Health Organization; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 19 strongly believes that the World Health Organization should be
- 20 supported, to the fullest extent possible, by all nations
