

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-78, 19-96, 19-132, 19-163, 20-03, 20-25, 20-58, 20-76, 20-116, 21-29 and 21-64, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social program in the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-51, 19-56, 19-72, 19-96, 19-163,
3 20-03 and 20-76, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$2,800,000
5 appropriated by his act, \$1,200,000 is
6 apportioned for public projects and social
7 programs in the state of Chuuk.

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1 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-10, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-26, 19-42, 19-72, 19-96, 20-25, 20-116,
3 21-29 and 21-64, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 “Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
5 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
6 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
7 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but
8 not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
9 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that
10 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
11 are used solely for the purpose specified in this
12 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
13 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds
14 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
15 Governor of Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
16 funds appropriated under subsection 2(h) of this act
17 shall be the President of COM-FSM. The allottee of
18 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
19 shall be the President of the Federated States of
20 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the
21 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
22 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j) and
23 (k) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town
24 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
25 subsection 3(y) of this act shall be the Mayor of

1 Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the
2 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
3 4(2)(g) and 4(2)(h) shall be the Secretary of the
4 Department of Transportation, Communications and
5 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated
6 under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(d) of
7 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
8 Authority; and the allottee of funds appropriated
9 under subsections 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(h) of this act
10 shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The
11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
12 5(1)[~~5(3)~~] and 5(6) of this act shall be the
13 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)
15 of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development
16 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of
18 Weno Municipal Government or his designee. The
19 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4)
20 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
21 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall
23 be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority
24 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by
25 this act shall lapse on September 30, [2020] 2022."

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
