

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115 and 21-137, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36 and 21-53, 21-56, 21-90,
3 21-115 and 21-137, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

22 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by
 23 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102 and 21-137, is
 24 hereby further amended to read as follows:

1 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
2 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
3 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
4 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
5 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
6 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
7 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
8 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
9 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
10 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
11 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
12 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
13 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
14 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT
15 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
16 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of
17 COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(an) of this
19 act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
20 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act shall be
22 the Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or his
23 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
24 section 4 of this act shall be the President of the
25 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED

1 THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under section
2 4(1) and subsection 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the
3 Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
4 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
5 subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act
6 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and
7 Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds
8 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and
9 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
10 Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of
11 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f)
12 and 4(3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
13 Transportation Authority, the funds appropriated under
14 subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the President of
15 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, the
16 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x)
17 of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of
18 Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee; the
19 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) of
20 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
21 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
22 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
23 subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Secretary
24 of the Department of Resources and Development or his
25 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under

1 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the
2 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of
3 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
4 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority
5 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
6 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
7 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
8 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
9 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
10 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
11 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
12 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
13 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
14 30, 2022.”

15 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
17 becoming law without such approval.
