
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-180, as amended by Public Law No. 21-191, by amending section 6 thereof, to change the allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-180, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 21-191, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
9 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
11 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
12 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
13 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
15 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
16 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
17 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
18 his designee; PROVIDED THAT; the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(b) of this act shall
2 be the Secretary of the Department of Health and Social
3 Affairs or his designee; the allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c) and 4(1)(d) of
5 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
6 Justice or his designee; the allottee of funds
7 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(e) of this act shall
8 be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and
9 Development or his designee; the allottee of funds
10 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(f) of this act shall
11 be the Secretary of the Department of [~~Finance and~~
12 ~~Administration~~] Transportation, Communications and
13 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
14 appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be the
15 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee
16 of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of this act
17 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town or his designee; the
18 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
19 4(1)(a), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),
20 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g) and 4(2)(h) of this act shall be the
21 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
22 Communications and Infrastructure; the allottee of funds
23 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(i) of this act shall
24 be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs Municipal Government;
25 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections

1 4(3)(a) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
2 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated
3 under subsection 4(3)(e) of this act shall be the Vice
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
5 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
6 subsections 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), and 4(3)(d) of this act
7 shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw. The allottee of
8 the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6)
9 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
10 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
11 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
12 Island Development Authority (MIDA), the allottee of
13 funds appropriated under section 5(3) of this act shall
14 be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
15 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
16 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
17 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
18 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
19 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
20 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
21 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2022.”

1 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
