**PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-07**

AN ACT

To further amend sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Law No. 21-01, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
