## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-60, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-71, 19-80, 19-103, 19-148, 19-165, 20-30, 20-128, 21-46 and 21-139, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding essential government functions, programs, projects and activities in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-60, as amended by

Public Laws Nos. 19-71, 19-80, 19-103, 20-30, 20-128, 21-46 and 21-139, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 3 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be 4 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 5 6 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not 7 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 8 9 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 10 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 11 12 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the 13 14 State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the 15 Governor of the State of Kosrae or his designee. 16 17 allottee of the funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Pohnpei 18 or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of the fund 19 20 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c), 4(2)(f), 21 4(3)(a), 4(3)(c) and 4(4)(a) shall be the Pohnpei 22 Transportation Authority (PTA). The allottee of funds 23 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(g), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(i), 4(2) and 4(4)(b) of 24 25 this act shall be the Secretary of Transportation,

1	Communications and Infrastructure or his designee. The
2	allottee of the funds appropriated under section 5 of
3	this act shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk or
4	his designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate
5	funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
6	30, 2022."
7	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
	becoming law without such approval.
