A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 19-145, 19-158, 20-09, 20-22, 20-51, 20-59, 20-70, 20-123, 20-162, 20-170, 21-35, 21-66, 21-112, 21-127, 21-176 and 21-198, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by
Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 19-145, 20-22, 20-51 and 20-162, is
hereby further amended to read as follows:
"Section 4. Of the sum of \$5,450,000 appropriated by
this act, \$1,200,000 is apportioned to fund public
projects and social programs for the people of the state
of Pohnpei.

the Department of Transportation, Communications and 1 2 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds 3 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of 4 funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) shall be 5 6 the Office of Fisheries, Pohnpei State; the allottee of 7 funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(n) shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his 8 9 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under 10 subsection 4(3)(b) shall be the Pohnpei State Public Safety; the allottee of funds appropriated under 11 12 subsections 4(3)(c) and 4(3(e) of this act shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; allottee of funds 13 14 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(m)shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of 15 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of 16 17 this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under 18 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock 19 20 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds 21 appropriated under section 5(3) of this act shall be 22 the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee. 23 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas 24 Development Authority. The allottee of funds 25

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1	appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be
2	the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of
3	the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
4	shall lapse on September 30, 2022."
5	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7	becoming law without such approval.
