A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19- 131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01, 20-14, 20-23, 20-74 and 20-129, in order to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein for the purpose of funding capital and human resources development for the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by
 Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01,
 20-14, 20-23 and 20-74, is hereby further amended to read as
 follows:

"Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. 5 The sum of \$40,606,363, which includes \$556,074 in SEG 6 7 funding that was previously omitted, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the 8 9 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the 10 following capital improvements, development programs, 11 12 and projects and human resources development. Of the 13 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,802,096 14 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the Supplemental Education Grant 15 and \$9,545,500 shall be deemed to come from funds 16 17 available under the Amended Compact from Compact Sector

4			not limited to, the Financial Management Act of

8			necessary, are used solely for the purpose
9			specified in this act, and that no obligations are
10			incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.
