A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-89, by amending sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein to fund priority infrastructure projects for the people of Yap State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 22-89 is hereby
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 1. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
4	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
5	Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
6	year ending September 30, 2022, to provide supplemental
7	funding for priority infrastructure projects for the
8	people of Yap State. The funds appropriated under this
9	section shall be apportioned as follows:
10	(1) State of Yap\$ 400,000
11	(a) [Solar System Upgrades for all the
12	Dispensaries and Schools in the outer islands of Yap, the
13	Fais & Woleai Airport Terminal Buildings, and or Cell
14	Phone Towers in the neighboring islands]
15	Telecommunication and Internet Services
16	Connectivity/Improvement on Satawal, Woleai atoll, Fais
17	<u>and Ulithi atoll</u> \$ 400,000"

1 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 22-89 is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 4 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be 5 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not 6 7 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 8 9 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 10 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no 11 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 12 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated 13 under section 1 of this act shall be the [Governor of Yap 14 State | President of the Federated States of Micronesia or 15 his designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate 16 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 17 30, 2024."
