

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-157, by amending sections 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use of fund previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 22-157 is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:
