A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, by inserting a new section 408 to regulate bunkering and provisioning activities at sea, and for the other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting a new section 408 to read as follows: 4 "Section 408. Related activities - Bunkering and 5 Provisioning. 6 (a) No fishing vessel shall engage in or conduct any bunkering or provisioning activities in the 7 Exclusive Economic Zone, except where specifically 8 9 authorized by the Authority. Bunkering and provisioning 10 activities are also prohibited in the high seas. (b) Where a fishing vessel is permitted by the 11 12 authority to conduct bunkering or provisioning 13 activities: 14 (i) it shall provide a seventy-two (72) hour advance notice to the Authority of a request to 15 conduct bunkering or provision activities and shall 16 17 provide the name of the vessel, its international radio call sign, its position, the time and location where

1	such bunkering or provisioning activities is requested
2	to occur and an undertaking to pay all fees required
3	under the laws of the Federated States of Micronesia;
4	and it shall comply with all conditions attached to the
5	authorizations for bunkering or provisioning activities;
6	(ii) it shall pay such fees required by the
7	Authority or as prescribed by regulation; and
8	(iii) it shall submit full reports on
9	bunkering or provisioning activities on such form as may
10	be required by the Authority or prescribed by
11	regulation.
12	(2) No purse seine fishing vessel shall, during the
13	validity of a license issued by the Authority, conduct
14	any bunkering or provisioning activities in the High
15	Seas of the Western and Central Pacific Fisheries
16	Commission Convention Area East of 130 degrees East and
17	South of 20 degrees North.
18	(3) For the purpose of this section, "bunkering
19	activities" means the transfer to or receiving from a
20	vessel fuel and oil, and "provisioning activities" means
21	the transfer to or receiving from a vessel any supplies
22	not limited to, food, cargoe, crew and spare parts
23	required by the vessel.

1	(4) Any person who violates this section shall be
2	subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$75,000 and
3	<pre>not more than \$275,000."</pre>
4	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
5	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
6	becoming law without such approval.
