REQUESTING THE PRESIDENT TO ALLOCATE ANY REMAINING GRANT FUNDING FOR COVID-19 RELIEF AT THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT LEVEL TO THE FOUR STATES TO ASSIST IN OUR NATION'S EFFORTS TO TRANSITION TO A SAFE, POST-PANDEMIC OPEN BORDER.

## A RESOLUTION

Requesting the President to allocate any remaining grant funding for COVID-19 relief at the National Government level to the four states to assist in our Nation's efforts to transition to a safe, postpandemic open border.

- WHEREAS, at the beginning of 2020 a new virus was identified, 1
- SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) which spread throughout almost the entire
- 3 world and resulted in over six million deaths in thirty months
- 4 worldwide;
- 5 WHEREAS, it was fortunate that at the beginning of this
- global pandemic the Federated States of Micronesia restricted
- 7 entry into the Nation beginning with the President's National
- 8 Public Health Emergency Declaration of March 14, 2020; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the extraordinary efforts of the National and State
- 10 Governments, and our citizens have fortunately allowed our Nation
- to avoid the spread of COVID-19 into the Federated States of 11
- 12 Micronesia, however, this has resulted in much economic and
- societal hardship for our citizens; and 13
- 14 WHEREAS, with the development of effective vaccines and
- 15 treatment for the COVID-19 virus a transition plan has been
- developed for a safe opening of the borders of our Nation, and it 16
- is the understanding of the Congress of the Federated States of 17
- 18 Micronesia that the majority of the remaining work to be done will
- 19 take place at the State Government level at their Offices of

1	Public Health, Departments of Health and hospitals; and
2	WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
3	wishes to ensure the remaining necessary work at the State
4	Government level regarding the post-pandemic border opening be
5	fully funded and completed at the earliest opportunity; now,
6	therefore,
7	BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia, Fifth Special Session, 2022, that the
9	Congress hereby requests the President allocate any remaining
10	grant funding for COVID-19 relief at the National Government level
11	to the four States to assist in our Nation's efforts to transition
12	to a safe, post-pandemic open border; and
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
14	resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
15	of Micronesia and to the Governor of each state of the Nation.
