Expressing the sincere condolences and sadness of the Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Honorable Roosevelt D. Kansou at his passing.

- 1 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Kansou had a long career of
- 2 public service; and
- 3 WHEREAS, after earning a bachelor's degree from the
- 4 University of Guam in 1975, he returned to Chuuk to teach for
- 5 three years before being appointed Vice Principal of Moen Junior
- 6 High School in 1978 and in 1979 he was appointed its Principal
- 7 then served as Principal of Truk High School during the school
- 8 year 1981-1982; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Kansou served in Chuuk State
- 10 Government as Chief of the Labor Division from 1983 to 1985 where he
- 11 was well thought of for his diligence and competence, then served
- 12 with distinction in the Chuuk State Legislature from 1986 to 1994,
- 13 first as the Vice Chairman of the House of Representatives Committee
- 14 on Federal and Foreign Affairs and then as the Chuuk House of
- 15 Representatives Chairman of the Committee on Judiciary and
- 16 Governmental Operations; and
- WHEREAS, the late Honorable Kansou was elected by special
- 18 election in February 1994 to the $8^{ ext{th}}$ Congress of the Federated
- 19 States of Micronesia where he served continuously until 2008;
- 20 and

WHEREAS, during his long service with the Congress the 1 Honorable Kansou first served as Vice Chairman of the Committee 2 on Transportation and Communication during the 10th Congress and 3 became its Chairman in the 11th Congress; and WHEREAS, the Honorable Kansou was known for having shown 5 leadership and for his hard work during his many years with the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; and 7 8 WHEREAS, since 1975 the late Honorable Kansou served Chuuk State and the National Government of the FSM: by teaching the 9 young people of our Nation; promoting safety in labor practices 10 and employment opportunities; and as an elected official driving 11 improvements in our Nation's infrastructure and communications, 12 as well as, judicial and foreign affairs; and 13 WHEREAS, the Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated States of 14 Micronesia greatly appreciates the hard work and commitment of the 15 late Honorable Kansou and his many contributions to this Nation, and 16 it would like to extend its sincere condolences to his family at his 17 18 passing; now, therefore, 19 BE IT RESOLVED, the by Twenty Second Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 2021, that Congress 20 hereby expresses its sincere condolences and sadness to the family 21 of the late Honorable Kansou at his passing, and
