TWENTY-SECOND CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

SEVENTH SPECIAL SESSION, 2023

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 22-286, C.D.1

AN ACT

To amend sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 of Public Law No. 22-153, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-169 and 22-181, to reallocate the funds for the 45% salary increase previously appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, by Public Law No. 22-181, by reducing the funds appropriated in Section 8 and placing them in the operational budget of the National Government, in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this bill is to
2 reallocate the funds for the 45% salary increase previously
3 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
4 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, by
5 Public Law No. 22-181, by reducing the funds appropriated in
6 Section 8 and placing them in the operational budget of the
7 national government, in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.

8 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 22-153, as amended
9 by Public Law No. 22-169 and 22-181, is hereby further amended
10 to read as follows:

11 "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch.
12 The sum of \$34,662,556, or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
14 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
15 year ending September 30, 2023, for the purpose of
16 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the
17 National Government during the fiscal year 2023. The

sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

(1) Office of the President.
