

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112, 18-122, 19-07, 19-24, 19-41, 19-52, 19-73, 19-82, 19-101, 19-114, 19-139, 20-07, 20-16, 20-36, 20-52, 20-81, 20-84 and 21-15, 21-113, 21-123, 21-175, 21-192, 21-208 and 21-222, by amending sections 3 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by Public  
2 Laws Nos. 18-98, 19-07, 19-24 and 19-114, is hereby further amended to  
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 3. Of the sum of \$5,100,000 appropriated by this  
5 act, \$750,000 is apportioned for public projects and social  
6 programs in the State of Kosrae.

13       Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by  
14 Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112, 18-122, 19-07, 19-24, 19-101, 20-  
15 07, 20-52, 20-84, 21-15 and 21-123, is hereby further amended to  
16 read as follows:

17       "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
18 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
19 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
20 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
21 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
22 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
23 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
24 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
25 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum

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1           appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
2           under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
3           State EXCEPT THAT the funds appropriated under  
4           subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM. The  
5           allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of  
6           this act shall be the President of the Federated States  
7           of Micronesia or his designee; EXCEPT THAT the funds  
8           appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h,  
9           i, j, k, l, m, n, o, s, t, u, v, w, x, ag, ah, aj, ap  
10          and aq of section 3 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu  
11          Town Government or his designee; the allottee of funds  
12          appropriated under subsections 3(y) and 3(ao) of this  
13          act shall be the Governor of Kosrae or his designee; the  
14          funds appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f  
15          and g of section 4(1), subsections 4(3)(b), (c), (d),  
16          (f), (p) and r of this act shall be the Pohnpei  
17          Transportation Authority, and the funds appropriated  
18          under subsection 4(3)(t) shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of  
19          Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
20          subsection 4(3)(aa) of this act shall be the Meninkeder  
21          Lapoloap of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds  
22          appropriated under subsection 4(4)(f) shall be the Mayor  
23          of Mwokilloa Municipal Government or his designee the  
24          allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(4)(l)  
25          shall be the Mayor of Pingelap Municipal Government or

1 his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
2 subsections 5(1) and 5(6), of this act shall be the  
3 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee  
4 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act  
5 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The  
6 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of  
7 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government  
8 or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated  
9 under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern  
10 Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
11 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be  
12 the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the  
13 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act  
14 shall lapse on September 30, 2022.”

15 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
17 becoming law without such approval.
