

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-60, 22-80, and 22-103, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriate therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 8 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 22-60, 22-80, and 22-103, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions.

5 The sum of \$~~[18,846,010]~~ 18,546,010, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
8 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, for the
9 following grants, subsidies and contributions during the

9 Public Law No. 22-80, is hereby further amended to read as
10 follows:

11 “Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
12 The sum of \$[~~14,786,505~~] 15,086,505 or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
14 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
15 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, for the
16 following capital improvements, development programs,
17 and projects and human resources development. Of the
18 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,542,202
19 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
20 Supplemental Education Grant and \$1,000,000 shall be
21 deemed to come from funds available under the Compact
22 Sector Grants. The sum appropriated by this section
23 shall be apportioned as follows:

14 Section 3. Section 12 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by
 15 Public Law No. 22-103, is hereby further amended to read as
 16 follows:

17 "Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and
 18 Lapse Dates.

19 (1) General provisions.

20 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 21 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 22 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
 23 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

24 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
 25 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
2 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
3 of the sums appropriated.

4 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
5 appropriated by this act are as follows:

6 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
7 shall be the President of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia;

9 (b) Section 3 and section 8(12)(w) - the
10 allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the
11 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;

12 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds
13 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
14 Federated States of Micronesia;

15 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds
16 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
17 Micronesia;

18 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
19 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
20 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
21 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

22 (i) Sections 8(1)(f) and 8(13)(q) - the
23 allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint
24 Committee on Compact Review and Planning;

1 (ii) Section 8(8)(a) – the allottee of these
2 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

3 (iii) Section 8(8)(b) – the allottee of these
4 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

5 (iv) Section 8(8)(c) – the allottee of these
6 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk,
7 except the for the \$75,000 for the Weno Municipal
8 Police, whom the allottee shall be the President of the
9 Federated States of Micronesia;

10 (v) Section 8(8)(d) – the allottee of these
11 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

12 (vi) Section 8(11) – the allottee of these
13 funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
14 Federated States of Micronesia;

15 (vii) Section 8(12)(a) – the allottee of
16 these funds shall be the President of the College of
17 Micronesia-FSM;

18 (viii) Section 8(12)(d) through (g) – the
19 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
20 the respective State Supreme Court;

21 (ix) Section 8(12)(h) – the allottee of
22 these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme
23 Court of the Federated States of Micronesia;

1 (x) Section 9(1) – the allottee of these
2 funds shall be the President of the College of
3 Micronesia-FSM;

4 (xi) Section 9(3)(b) – the allottee of these
5 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

6 (xii) Section 9(3)(b) – the allottee of these
7 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;

8 (xiv) Section 9(3)(c) – the allottee of these
9 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;

10 (xv) Section 9(3)(d) – the allottee of these
11 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

12 (xvi) Section 9(3)(e) – the allottee of these
13 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;

14 (xvii) Section 9(11)(b) – the allottee of
15 these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
16 Federated States of Micronesia; [~~and~~]

17 (xviii) Section 9(11)(d) – the allottee of
18 these funds shall be the President of the Constitutional
19 Convention; and

20 (xix) Section 9(11)(o) – the allottee of these
21 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk.

22 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
23 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
24 of September 30, 2022; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
