

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-141, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-145, 20-163, 20-164, 20-190, 21-05, 21-33, 21-48, 21-67, 21-91, 21-182, 21-193, 22-34, 22-69 and 22-77, by amending sections 2 and 3 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the states of Yap and Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 20-141, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 21-48 and 22-69, is hereby further amended to  
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 2. Of the \$12,800,000 appropriated under this  
5 act, \$2,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority  
6 infrastructure projects and other projects and programs  
7 in the state of Yap.
