A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-186, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-189, 23-01 and 23-14, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 8 9 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The 10 11 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 12 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 13 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no 14 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 15 appropriated.
