A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-101, 22-102, 22-106, 22-140, 22-147, 22-161, 22-168, 22-185, 22-197, 23-06, 23-12 and 23-39, by amending sections 2, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by 3 Public Laws Nos. 22-102, 22-140, 22-168, 23-12 and 23-39, is 4 hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be 6 7 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not 8 9 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The 10 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 11 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 12 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that 13 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 14 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated 15 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap 16 State or his designee. The allottee of funds 17 appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae or his designee; the 18 19 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of 20 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or 21 his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the President of the 22 23 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED 2.4 THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under

subsection 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the FSM

Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(g) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(1), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e) 4(3)(f), 4(3)(g) and 4(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(j), 4(2)(d) and 4(3)(1) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and Development or her designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(1), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(2)(g), 4(3)(a), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(f) 4(3)(k), 4(3)(p), 4(3)(s), 4(3)(u), 4(3)(z), 4(3)(aa) and 4(3)(ab), of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(k) of this act shall be the President of the COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(i) 4(3)(o) and 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection

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4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(n), 4(3)(v), 4(3)(w), 4(3)(x), of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(y) of this act shall be the Luhkenmenlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(t) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), $[\frac{5(2)}{2}]$ and 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1)(a) and 5(1)(b) of this act shall be the [Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee | Governor of Chuuk State or his designee and the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(i) of this act shall be the Saramen Chuuk Academy School; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 5(2) of this act shall be the At large Office; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated

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1	under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Southern
2	Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
3	funds appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act
4	shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
5	authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated

7	Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9	becoming law without such approval.
