A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-60, 22-80, 22-103 and 22-141, to modify the use of Capital and Human Resources Development funding and change the allottee of such funds previously appropriated therein to fund the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia for fiscal year September 30, 2022; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 22-80 and 22-141, is hereby further amended to
- 3 read as follows:

- 5 The sum of \$16,083,505 or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
- 7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
- 8 ending September 30, 2022, for the following capital
- 9 improvements, development programs, and projects and
- 10 human resources development. Of the total amount of funds
- 11 appropriated herein, \$1,542,202 shall be deemed to come
- 12 from funds available under the Supplemental Education
- Grant and \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come from funds
- 14 available under the Compact Sector Grants. The sum
- appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
- 16 follows:

5	Section 6. Section 12 of Public Law No. 22-42, as amended by
6	Public Laws Nos. 22-103 and 22-141, is hereby further amended to
7	read as follows:
8	"Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse
9	<u>Dates</u> .
10	(1) General provisions.
11	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
12	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
13	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
14	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
15	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
16	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
17	necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
18	this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
19	of the sums appropriated.
20	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
21	appropriated by this act are as follows:
22	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
23	be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

1	(b) Section 3 and section 8(12)(w) - the allottee
2	of these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of
3	the Federated States of Micronesia;
4	(c) Section 4 — the allottee of these funds shall
5	be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
6	Federated States of Micronesia;
7	(d) Section 5 — the allottee of these funds shall
8	be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
9	Micronesia;
10	(e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
11	funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
12	Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
13	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
14	(i) Sections $8(1)(f)$ and $8(13)(q)$ — the
15	allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint
16	Committee on Compact Review and Planning;
17	(ii) Section $8(8)(a)$ — the allottee of these
18	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
19	(iii) Section $8(8)(b)$ — the allottee of these
20	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
21	(iv) Section $8(8)(c)$ — the allottee of these
22	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk, except
23	the for the \$75,000 for the Weno Municipal Police, whom
24	the allottee shall be the President of the Federated
25	States of Micronesia;

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1	(v) Section $8(8)(d)$ — the allottee of these
2	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
3	(vi) Section $8(11)$ — the allottee of these
4	funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
5	Federated States of Micronesia;
6	(vii) Section $8(12)(a)$ — the allottee of these
7	funds shall be the President of the College of
8	Micronesia-FSM;
9	(viii) Section 8(12)(d) through (g) - the
10	allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the
11	respective State Supreme Court;
12	(ix) Section 8(12)(h) - the allottee of these
13	funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of
14	the Federated States of Micronesia;
15	(x) Section $9(1)$ - the allottee of these
16	funds shall be the President of the College of
17	Micronesia-FSM;
18	(xi) Section $9(3)(b)$ - the allottee of these
19	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
20	(xii) Section $9(3)(b)$ - the allottee of these
21	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
22	(xiv) Section $9(3)(c)$ - the allottee of these
23	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
24	(xv) Section $9(3)(d)$ - the allottee of these
25	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;

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1	(xvi) Section $9(3)(e)$ - the allottee of these
2	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
3	(xvii) Section $9(11)(b)$ - the allottee of
4	these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
5	Federated States of Micronesia; and
6	(xviii) (Section $9(11)(d)$ - the allottee of
7	these funds shall be the President of the Constitutional
8	Convention;
9	(xix) Section $9(8)(0)$ — the allottee of these
10	funds shall be the Secretary of the Department of
11	Health[+];
12	(xx) Section 9(4)(d)(iii) - the allottee of
13	these funds shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal
14	Government.
15	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
16	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
17	September 30, 2022; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
18	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not
19	lapse."
20	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
21	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
22	becoming law without such approval.
