## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137, 20-29, 20-86, 20-119, 21-31, 21-160, 22-18, 22-72, 22-122, 22-174, and 22-200, by amending section 1 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-64, as amended
by Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137, 20-29, 20-119,
22-18, 22-72, 22-174 and 22-200, is hereby further amended to
read as follows:

5 Purpose. The sum of \$3,050,000, or so much "Section 1. thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from 6 7 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the 9 purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the states of Kosrae and Pohnpei. The funds 10 11 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as 12 follows:
