## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 9 of Public Law No. 22-153, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-169, 22-181, 23-08, and 23-13, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund support for the acquisition of an FSM Embassy property in Washington D.C., and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 22-153, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 22-169, 22-281, 23-08 and 23-13, is hereby
- 3 further amended to read as follows:

- funds appropriated herein, \$1,534,539 shall be deemed to
- come from funds available under the Supplemental
- Education Grant and \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come
- 14 from funds available under the Compact Sector Grants.
