A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03 and 23-09, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

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Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by 2 Public Law No. 22-188, is hereby further amended to read as 3 follows: 4 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 5 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 6 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited 7 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee 8 9 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so 10 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the 11 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee 12 of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall 13 14 be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee 15 of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of 16 17 Micronesia or his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of 18 funds appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be 19 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act shall 20 21 be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the 22 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(1), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 23 24 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n), 4(2)(p), 4(2)(s), 25 4(2)(t), 4(2)(u) and 4(2)(v) of this act shall be the

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Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(j), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(1), 4(2)(m), 4(2)(r), 4(2)(x), 4(3)(m) and 4(2)(n) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(w), 4(2)(q), $[\frac{4(2)(y)}{2}]$ and 4(2)(z) of this act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of the finds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(y) of this act shall be the Mayor of Sokehs Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development

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           Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
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           subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk
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           Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to
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           obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
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           September 30, 2025.
