A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-101, 22-102, 22-106, 22-140, 22-147, 22-168, 22-185, 22-197 and 23-06, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

14	Public Laws Nos. 22-102, 22-140 and 22-168, is hereby further
15	amended to read as follows:
16	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
17	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
19	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
20	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
21	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
22	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
23	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
24	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
25	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or The allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(g) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(1), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d),4(3)(e) 4(3)(f), 4(3)(q) and 4(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(j), 4(2)(d) and 4(3)(1) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and Development or her designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(1), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(2)(g),

4(3)(a), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(j) 4(3)(k), 4(3)(p), 4(3)(s), 4(3)(u), 4(3)(z), 4(3)(aa) and 4(3)(ab), of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(k) of this act shall be the President of the COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(i) 4(3)(o) and 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(n), 4(3)(v), 4(3)(w), 4(3)(x), of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(y) of this act shall be the Luhkenmenlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(t) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(2) and 5(7) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 5(1)(a) and 5(1)(b) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal

Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds 1 2 appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be 3 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the 4 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of 5 this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated 6 7 under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the Southern 8 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the 9 funds appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act 10 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The 11 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated 12 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2024." 13 Section 2.
